
How to cross a picket line. . .

In the event of a strike, union members face a difficult choice...to cross or not to cross a picket line. This is a difficult decision and should always be left to the individual. Even union members have the right to choose.

If a union member decides it is in his/her best interest for those who depend on his/her paycheck, the member has the right to cross the picket line. Most union constitutions call for discipline to those who cross picket lines. To be free from that discipline a member must resign from the union. Once that resignation is received by the union, the member may cross the picket line and not be fired or disciplined.
